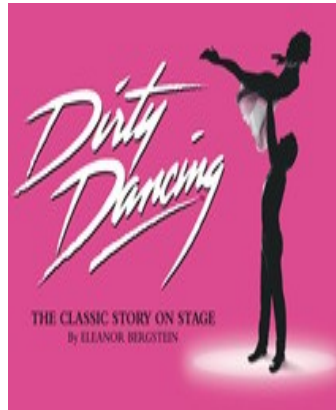


Theatre Trip
